





The Post-Hurricane Maria Aid for Researchers Grant Program is available to Caribbean (Puerto Rico and USVI) undergraduate and graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, faculty and K-12 STEM educators to apply for support of their recovery efforts in the wake of Hurricane Maria.

Please be sure to carefully review the funding criteria, the types of applications that may be submitted, and the information that will be required for your application as described here: <u>http://prsciencetrust.org/help-for-researcher/</u>. BEFORE PROCEEDING with an application, please be sure to review the <u>more than 400 offers</u> of work space, reagents, and aid received through the <u>Ciencia Puerto Rico network</u>. If you are applying for CONTINUITY FUNDS, please contact the investigators on this list, or from among your own contacts, and discuss the possibility of a visiting position or other forms of assistance <u>before</u> you submit your application. You will need a letter of support from your host before your application can be considered for funding.

BUDGET INFORMATION: Continuity and thesis awards will be limited to \$1,000. Restoration awards may vary, but will not exceed \$2,000 per grant. The applications will be evaluated as competitive merit awards and awardees will be selected on the basis of the number of applications received, availability of funds, demonstration of need, and alignment with the priorities of funding partners. *Only one submission per individual will be accepted so please consider your request carefully.*

STEP 1 of 2: APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE

This form allows you to provide details regarding your request for funds in one of three tracks: **CONTINUITY, RESTORATION**, and **THESIS**.

Continuity funds: To support researchers who need to relocate temporarily to continue research projects with collaborators outside the Caribbean region. Funds may be used to support travel costs, registration for conferences. *Award requests of up to \$1,000.*

Restoration Funds: To help in restocking lost materials lost, repairing damaged equipment and/or rehabilitating teaching or research facilities. *Award requests of up to \$2,000.*

Thesis Funds: To allow undergraduate or graduate students who are within a year of completing their degree and intend to pursue a teaching or research career in the Caribbean region. Applicants must have completed all departmental and institutional requirements for their degree, with the exception of writing and defending the thesis. *Award requests of up to \$1,000.*
